Drone Alliance Europe Welcomes Adoption of Harmonized Drone Rules Across Europe

Brussels – 29 May 2019 – On 24 May, the European Commission formally adopted a Delegated Act “on unmanned aircraft intended for use in the open category, and on third-country operators of unmanned aircrafts systems” and an Implementing Regulation “on the rules and procedures for the operation of unmanned aircraft”.

Drone Alliance Europe (DAE) actively contributed to the public consultations that the European Commission conducted on the Delegated Act and Implementing Regulation throughout 2018 and welcomes these regulations as an important step in the journey towards a fully harmonised European drone regulatory framework.

“The formal adoption of the regulations allows for the implementation of strong safety requirements and establishes the foundations to enable the further development of the European drone services market,” said DAE Executive Director Christoph Raab.

The regulations also contemplate the development of a U-space air traffic management system. DAE and its members are actively involved in this effort, contributing in a number of ways, including by participating in the demonstrator network program.
